Atomic Testing Museum Marks National Day of Remembrance and Service

Discounted admission offered on September 11th, 2010

LAS VEGAS, NV - In honor of the National Day of Service and Remembrance on **September 11th**, the Atomic Testing Museum is offering discounted ticket prices of \$5.00 for all visitors. Earlier this year the museum became the permanent home for two exceptional artifacts from the World Trade Center in New York City. The dedication ceremony, held in February was attended by over 600 guests. The pieces went on display shortly thereafter. The museum is still collecting donations for the construction of the permanent exhibit.

Next year will mark the 10th Anniversary of the 9/11 Terrorist Attacks. The museum will hold a large memorial service in honor of the victims and their families.

On September 11, 2010, the museum will be open from 10 am to 5pm.

About the Atomic Testing Museum

Founded in 1998 to preserve the legacy of the Nevada Test Site, the museum's parent organization, Nevada Test Site Historical Foundation was founded with a mission to document

and interpret the unique history associated with 50+ years of nuclear weapons research and testing conducted at the Test Site. At the Museum we interpret that history for the public. We strive to conserve this history and place it within the context of state, national, and global importance.

The Atomic Testing Museum is open 7 days a week, Monday through Saturday from 10 am to 5pm and Sundays from 12 pm to 5 pm; last tickets are sold at 4:30 p.m. to allow time to tour the Museum. Admission is \$12 for adults, \$9 for Seniors, Military w/ ID, and Students w/ ID. \$9 for Youths 7-17. Children under 7 are FREE.

The Atomic Testing Museum is an Affiliate of the Smithsonian Institution and a member of the American Association of Museums. We are located at 755 E. Flamingo Road, between Paradise and Swenson on the south side of the street. We have ample parking and are ADA accessible.
